This Wednesday we begin the season of Lent. This penitential season encourages us to purify our minds and hearts for the Lord. A reminder that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast and Abstinence from meat. The Fridays of Lent are also days of prayer and are observed by either abstinence from meat, extra prayer, service or charity or devotional practices like the Stations of the Cross or the Rosary or personal prayer. The Lenten timetable for the Bayside communities is in this bulletin.

One of the important ways that we observe Lent is by our generosity to others in service and charity. The Project Compassion boxes and envelopes are available in the churches for you to take home this weekend.

This past week we have celebrated liturgies for the beginning of the school year for our six schools and this Wednesday we will celebrate liturgies for Ash Wednesday for all the schools as well. We are planning times for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion before Easter to catch up on the sacraments for last year. Our school staff are doing a great job in facilitating all of this for us.

On Wednesday evening we met with the Interim Mission and Stewardship Teams and we are now in the process of forming our new Bayside Pastoral Council and Finance Committee. Each community will discern the members of the new groups to represent them in our new structures (more details in the bulleting, which were announced last week.

As Bayside Catholics, let's do our best to make this Lent really count, so that we may celebrate Easter well.

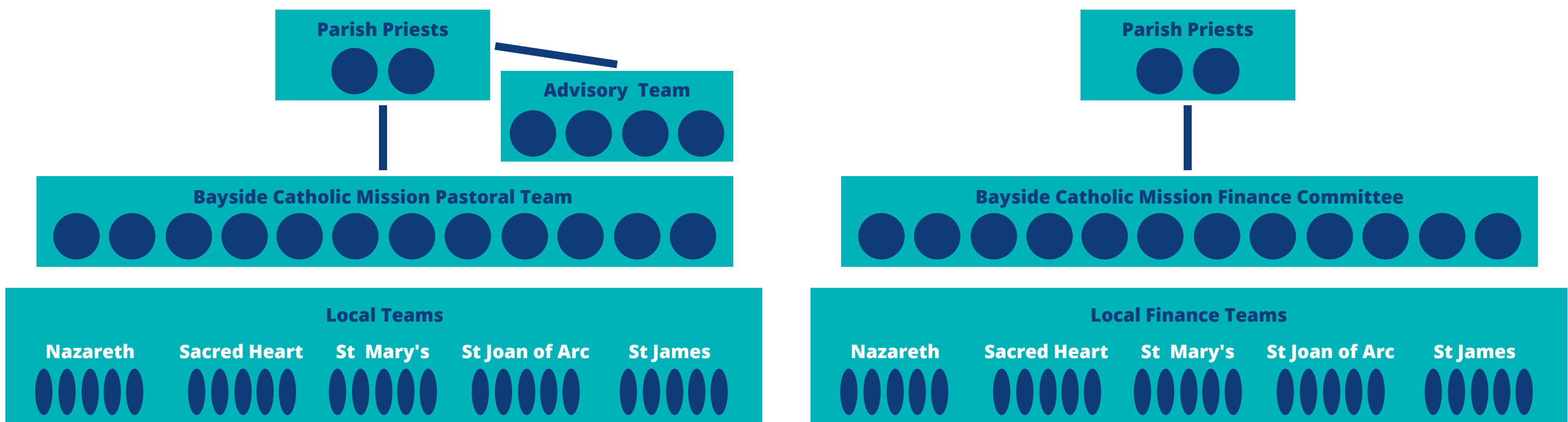
