Overwhelmed by enemies he pleads for being made an object of mockery. The sense of humiliation and reproach are so stressful that it has made him physically ill.

The response expresses the psalmist plea for help. It echoes the lament of Jerusalem in the face of hostility and scorn. The emphasis shifts from the plight of the petitioner to the goodness and trustworthiness of God.
