Palm Sunday

My God, my God why have you abandoned me?.

Psalm 21 portrays an intensity of feeling expressed through vigorous images. An urgent petition and also a triumphant hope. The person who prays the psalm is full of anguish and seeks God with eager longing.

The prayer is made in a moment of intense suffering and abandonment. The psalmist describes his suffering in words that move our heart and grip our imagination. More than physical is the anguish of mind. In the midst of it, he finds communion with God.

The transition from distress to praise is made clear. The first three verses focus on human suffering. But the fourth is a bout of joyful praise. The response to the psalm is in keeping with the passion story of Mark that we read today.
