Psalm 22 is a joyful song of thanksgiving.
This psalm of trust is full of images and
symbols taken from the pastoral and family
life of the Bedouins. These symbols include
water, green pastures, shelter, oil, cup.

The experience of God's providence becomes
the basis of the present calm and future life.

Daily realities help the psalmist to give
expressions to his inner feelings. The
Psalmist is not afraid of any peril. The rod
and staff are signs of God's protection.

This psalm is one of the best known and most
loved of all. It appears several times in the
three year cycle of the lectionary. The psalm
challenges us to experience God's personal
