The Lord gave them Bread from Heaven

Psalm 77 recounts the history of Israel from the Exodus down to the time of King David. God's saving love for his people is contrasted with the people's disobedience and waywardness. God manifests his justice by defending the helpless victims of oppression.

The poet remembers the great deeds of God. How he gave bread from heaven. God's presence is at once revealing and mysterious.

The psalm concludes with a consoling revelation where God feeds his people with **manna, the bread from heaven**. The abundance of food is given to all who hunger for the Lord. In a mysterious way God shows that he is still the Lord of his people.
