### REDEEMING

On Passion (Palm) Sunday we have two Gospels. One for the Blessing of Palms and the other the Passion of Jesus according to Luke. We are invited to immerse ourselves in the passion of Jesus. Follow Him with palms to the Cross. The Cross is the symbol of our Redemption. The whole redemptive act is the Passion and Death of Jesus on the Cross. Luke brings out the meaning of the death of Jesus. He died as human love, enacting the divine love that drove his entire mission His death brought forgiveness, healing, assurance, peace and justice.

We are invited to follow the example of Jesus and empty ourselves embracing humility and selflessness, not just to lay down ones clothes or just holding palm branches. This means deepening our service of others in the coming weeks.

This Act of Redemption is also called the Paschal Mystery- the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus.


### Liz Dawson:
